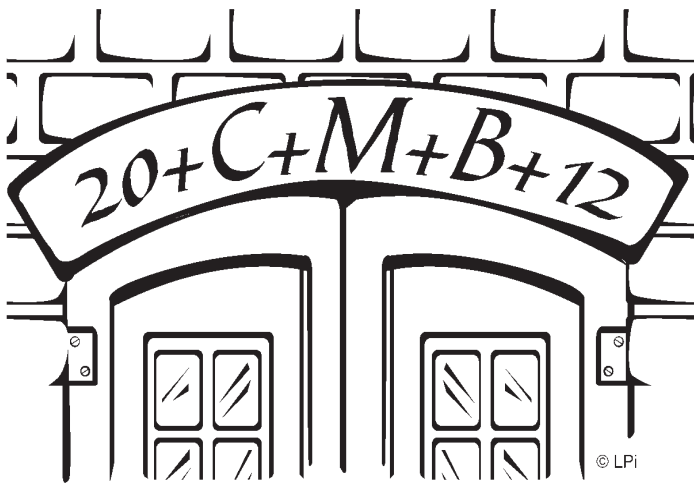
**WEDNESDAY NIGHT DINNERS**
